- All entries must be in place by 12 noon Saturday Sept. 11th, 2010.
- Buds showing colour are counted as a bloom.
- Spray is a portion of the plant with a number of flowers on one stem (eg. Chrysanthemum).
- Spike is an upright stem with several flowers (eg. Gladioli).
- Arrangement is a combination of fresh and/or dried plant materials and/or inorganic objects arranged to produce an artistic unit.
- Display is a specified number of cut flowers, potted plants, branches, fruits and vegetables and nuts, exhibited for an artistic effect as well as cultural perfection.
- Flowers must be grown by the exhibitor.
- ***CUT FLOWERS ARE TO BE IN A STABLE, FLAT BOTTOM & WEIGHTED CONTAINER TO PREVENT TIPPING WHEN HANDLED BY THE JUDGE OR COMMITTEE.***
- Note: Section items marked \*\*\* denotes that the First Prize Winner will be donating their entry toward the Auction held during opening ceremonies on Saturday evening with proceeds going to the flower prize money
- All entries must be picked up at 4:30pm Sunday Sept. 12th

## Class 21 Potted Plants

**Note: Potted plant containers not to exceed 12”**

### Sections

1. **Hanging Planter**, in bloom, outdoor grown
2. **Hanging Planter**, without bloom, outdoor grown
3. **Outdoor Patio Planter**, 3 or more varieties of annuals
4. **Coleus**, 1 plant per pot
5. **Geranium in bloom**, in orange tones
6. **Geranium**, with variegated leaves, any colour
7. **Houseplant**, without bloom
8. **Houseplant**, in bloom
9. **Dish Garden**, cactus or succulent
10. **Decorative & Unusual Potted Plant**, one variety, named

## Class 22      **Cut Flowers**

**Note:** *Cut flowers are to be in a stable, flat bottom & weighted container to prevent tipping when handled by the judge or committee.*

### Sections

11. **Gladioli**, single, any colour with foliage,
12. **Gladioli**, 3 spikes, 3 different colours
13. **Gladioli**, 3 spikes, one colour
14. **Sunflowers**, any variety, 5 blooms
15. **Hosta Leaves**, 3 different varieties, 2 stems each
16. **Cosmos**, 3 sprays, not to exceed 18" high
17. **Chrysanthemum**, 3 sprays
18. **Aster**, any variety, 3 blooms
19. **Dahlia**, 3" & over, 1 bloom
20. **Dahlia**, less than 3", 1 bloom
21. **Dahlia**, any variety, 3 blooms
22. **Marigold**, orange, under 3" miniature, 5 blooms
23. **Marigold**, orange, 3" and over, 5 blooms
24. **Sweet Peas**, annual or perennial, 3 sprays
25. **Pansy**, best display with foliage
26. **Petunia**, 3 sprays, single
27. **Petunia**, 3 sprays, double
28. **Rose**, 3 blooms in vase
29. **Rose**, 1 bloom in vase
30. **Snapdragon**, 3 spikes
31. **Zinnia**, over 2.5", 5 blooms
32. **Zinnia**, miniature, under 2.5", 5 blooms
33. **Batchelor Buttons**, any colour, 5 blooms
34. **Calendula**, any colour, 5 blooms
35. **Any unusual flower not mentioned**, stalks or sprays, 3 blooms, please name
